## Level 2 Travel and Tourism Course Overview

### Who is the course for?

This course is suitable for you if you want to gain an understanding into the Travel and Tourism industry – one of London's biggest employment sectors.

This course will allow you to develop transferrable skills in customer service, planning, research and communication.

### How will I be assessed?

You will be completing 3 units of work. 2 of these are coursework based which are internally marked and externally moderated by Pearson. The third is the external exam component which can be taken twice during the year.

### What could I do after the course?

After the course you could progress onto employment since the course provides you with the essential knowledge and tools for the world of work.

If you choose to continue in the 6<sup>th</sup> Form / Further Education, you could progress onto various Level 3 courses for a more specialist study. These courses include both BTEC and A Level courses in various subjects.

### What else do I need to know?

The qualification is graded over seven grades from Level 1 Pass to Level 2 Distinction\*. Learners must achieve all components at Level 1 Pass or above in order to be awarded a qualification.

### What will I be studying?

You will be studying 3 mandatory units:

- Travel and Tourism Organisations and Destinations
- Customer Needs in Travel and Tourism
- Influences on Global Travel and Tourism
